

European and East Asian Governance

Program Content

In this Master's program, you will analyze how the European Union and East Asia, mainly China, adapt to often disruptive and transformative economic and political changes. The European integration experience, EU decision-making and key EU policies such as economic, security and environmental policies are studied and compared with institutions, policy-making and forms of regional cooperation in East Asia.

This Master's program introduces you to a variety of theoretical perspectives, mainly from political science, and equips you with strong analytical skills. These will be applied to deal with real-life problems through decision-making simulations and policy-oriented case studies. The Master's program „European and East Asian Governance“ is a two-year full-time program consisting of 10 modules, including an optional 8-week internship.

Career Perspectives

Our Master's program's strong focus on practical policy issues, its field trips to European institutions and an internship prepare you for a career in regional or national governments, in EU institutions or EU-related organizations, in interest groups, in private companies or non-profit organizations.

This program's main focus is on European politics, governance, and law. These are compared to East Asian – in particular Chinese – institutions, governance frameworks and policies. A special emphasis is laid on comparative and international political economy, security and environmental issues and policies.

Who can apply?

You'll need solid English language skills, certified by a language test such as TOEFL, the Cambridge English Language Test or equivalent tests.

No proof of German language skills is required (No DSH / TestDaF).
